President's Message

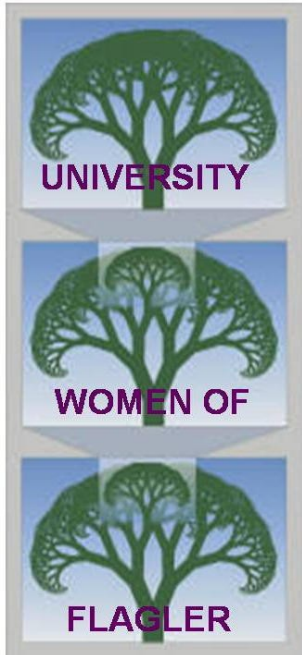

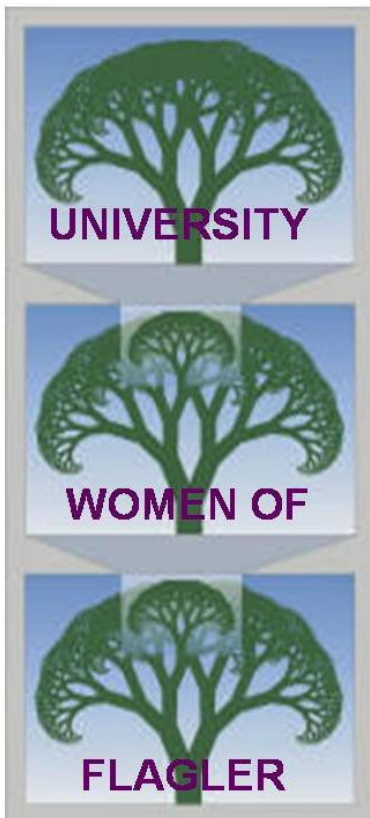
