**New Members** Ideas from new member meeting are as follows:

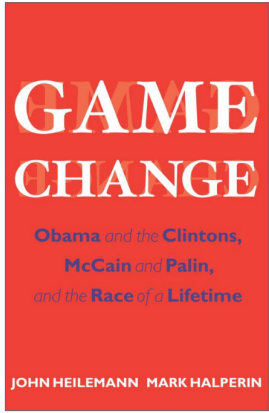
